



Cuba Si Tours Harley Motorcycle Island Tour 8-14 Nights+ Flexible Jan-Mar 2012

*4 nights in historical Havana, 1 night in French Colonial Cienfuegos, 2 nights in Spanish Colonial Trinidad and 1 night in revolutionary Santa Clara. *Option to add extra days relaxing at vibrant Varadero Beach, serene Cayo Largo, secluded Cayo Levisa, upscale Cayo Santa Maria or exploring Havana.*

Day 1: arrive at Havana or Varadero airport on your selected flight today. You will be met at the airport by our Company Representative with private transfer to your Havana hotel, extra cost from Varadero. Check-in, welcome drink and orientation. Relax or explore on your own. Tonight dinner and show to be arranged.

Hotel to be announced 4* with breakfast daily.

Day 2: breakfast at your hotel. Walking around the old city Plazas of Havana Vieja and then departure from Plaza San Francisco by Coach. Visit to the Fortresses El Morro and La Cabaña with lunch at Doce Apóstolos with a view of the bay and city skyline. In the afternoon pick up of bikes and ride to the home of the American author and Nobel Prize winner Ernest Hemingway, Finca La Vigia. If time allows, we will go by the port of Cojimar where Hemingway used to fish. Tonight Spanish Flamenco Show & dinner in Old Town.

Day 3: breakfast at your hotel. Departure for a ride to the scenic mountain area of Viñales. We will see the caves of Cueva del Indio, a rock wall painting Mural de la Prehistoria and then lunch at a tobacco plantation where we will hear about growing of tobacco. Return to hotel. This evening options for dinner and music.

Day 4: breakfast at your hotel. Depart on the Cuban "Autopista". Even though it is considered a highway, you will still meet horse wagons, bicyclists and livestock on the road. Then a boat trip on Laguna del Tesoro at La Boca de Cienaga de Zapata and a visit to the crocodile farm at Guama Eco Park. Lunch at Cueva de los Peces before heading to Playa Girón and the historic site of The Bay of Pigs. Afterwards we will continue towards the French Colonial town of Cienfuegos, visit the beautiful square Parque Martí with famous theatre Tomás Terrý. Check-in to your hotel and relax. Dinner and a visit to former historic Palacio del Valle.

Day 5: breakfast at your hotel. Depart Cienfuegos and we will see a dolphin show at Rancho Luna, for an extra charge you can experience a swim with them also. After the show we will go to a private restaurant Paladar for lunch. Following along the coast line of the Caribbean Sea we enter into Colonial Spanish Trinidad. With original cobblestones and old town houses it's like travelling several hundred years back in time. We will visit the Plaza Mayor with a plantation owner's colonial museum home that gives a good impression of the wealth of the town during that time period based on sugar and slavery. Check-in to your hotel and relax. This evening dinner and outdoor salsa show at Casa de la Musica.

Day 6: breakfast at your hotel. The day starts with a ride out to the mountains of Escambray and the view points at La Hanabanilla and Mirador. Back to Trinidad for lunch and then you have options, you can explore on your own, relax at the hotel or go with our guide to the beautiful beach of Playa Ancon. Dinner and Afro-Cuban show this evening. Options also to go to Casa de La Musica or Cave Disco.

Day 7: breakfast at your hotel. This morning we will travel to Santa Clara, one of the most important towns of the revolution via Valle de los Ingenios and historic Manaca Iznaga Plantation, where we will stop for the view and a cup of Guarapa, the juice from the sugar canes, also called Cuban Red Bull. Then a stop at the main square of the city of Sancti Spiritus continuing onward with a visit to the mausoleum and statue of Ché Guevara, revolutionary hero, who captured Santa Clara during the Christmas of 1958 and moved on to Havana thus ending the dictatorship of Batista. Lunch will be in Santa Clara and check-in to hotel. Dinner is at our hotel Los Caneyes where we will be accompanied by some of the local “Harlistaes” from Santa Clara for a visit.

Day 8: breakfast at your hotel. Our journey closes as we head back to Havana and we will mainly ride the Autopista. We will make a stop at Los Morales for lunch, before dropping off the bikes and then go to our hotel in Havana. A farewell dinner is planned and for those of you who have booked a night at the famous Cabaret Tropicana, your coach will pick you up at our hotel.

Day 9-15: breakfast at your hotel. Transfer from your hotel to the airport at the appropriate time for your departure flight home. Option at extra cost to stay and explore Havana’s historical museums and galleries on your own or transfer and check-in to your all-inclusive beach resort hotel, enjoy water sports and relax.

Options that can be added pre or post tour:

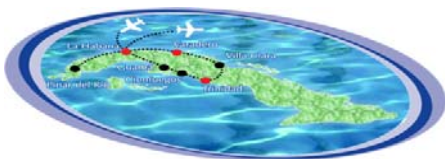
- Option 1 - Stay in Varadero to relax at the beautiful beach and enjoy the historic town.

- Option 5 - Transfer by car to a scenic ecological village in the mountains for hiking.
- Option 6 - Transfer by car to a Havana Hotel with breakfast daily to explore more of this vibrant city.
